RACING CHAMPIONSHIP
REGULATIONS**

GENERAL

All events in the 2021 AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship will be conducted in accordance with these New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship Regulations, the Event Regulations, any Additional Regulations and/or Announcements/Bulletins as published by the Organisers.

All events will be conducted with consideration to risk management and occupational, health and safety.

1. SERIES SCHEDULE

The 2021 AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship will consist of the following rounds:

Round 1 Pooncarie 16-18th April 2021

Round 2 Griffith 2-4th July 2021

ADVERTISING

By entering any event in the 2021 AORRA New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship, Clubs, Corporations and persons agree to refer to the series by its full title: - 2021 AORRA New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship. All promotional material must include the full title.

EVENTS

General

Running of the event will be as per Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations issued by Event Organiser.

Combined Event

The race distance of any club portion of a combined event can only be a maximum of 75% of the total distance of the state event.

Finisher

To be classified as a finisher a crew must complete 100% of the complete course within the time duration allowed by the organisers, as specified in the Event Regulations.

POINTS

Points will be awarded as per the following Point Score.

Only the driver is eligible for points. Competitors are only eligible for points with one entry per event. A driver can nominate a navigator to receive end of series awards.

Competitors are required to register to be eligible for the 2021 AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship points. Registration closes Friday at 8pm.

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd Outright,
Class Trophies will be awarded as follows - 1st place minimum 2 in a class, 2nd place minimum of 4 in a class and 3rd place minimum of 6 in a class. Must be a minimum of 2 competitors in a class to be acknowledged as a Class Champion.

The points will be published on aorra.com.au and offroadracing.com.au

START AND FINISH POINTS

Start points

5 outright points and 5 class points will be awarded to each valid entry prepared to start the event. (i.e. entered crew and vehicle presented for scrutiny at the event scrutiny venue).

Finish points

10 outright points and 10 class points will be awarded to each series registered competitor who has completed 100% of the entered event.

OUTRIGHT AND CLASS POINTS

Outright and class points will be awarded based on laps completed and total elapsed time to each competitor who completes 75% or more of the event relative to all other AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship registered competitors according to the tables below, provided they meet all other requirements.

TITLES AND AWARDS

The 2021 AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship awards will be presented at the Griffith event.

To be eligible for 2021 AORRA Race Wheels Australia New South Wales Off Road Racing Championship points you must have entered and started both events and be classified as a finisher at 1 event.

TIES/COUNTBACK • Outright In the event of a tie within the top three placings outright, the winner will be determined by a countback - whomever had the higher outright finishing positions.

- Class In the event of a tie within the top three placings of a class, the winner will be determined by a countback - whomever had the higher class finishing positions. If the competitors earned the same class finishing positions the winner will be decided on who placed higher in the outright Championship points. In the event of a tie for the outright position, the winner will be decided on whomever had the higher outright finishing positions throughout the year.
