1. GENERAL

All events in the 2021 Mickey Thompson ARB Queensland Off Road Racing Championship will be conducted under the National Competition Rules of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), AASA Standing Regulations for Off Road Racing Events and in accordance with these Queensland Off Road Racing Championship Regulations, the Event Regulations, any Additional Regulations and/or Announcements/Bulletins as published by the Organisers.

All events will be conducted with consideration to risk management and occupational, health and safety

3. ADVERTISING

All vehicles competing in the championship may be asked to display sponsors stickers on each side of their vehicles.

4. EVENTS

General running of the events will be as per Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations issued by Event Organiser.

Enduro Event – an off road race on a course exceeding 20 km which exceeds 100 km in total length.

Sprint Event (short course)– an off road race on a course less than 20 km which does not exceed 160 km in total length

5. POINTS

Points will be awarded as per the following:

Start points

5 outright points and 5 class points will be awarded to each valid entry prepared to start the event. (i.e. entered crew and vehicle presented for scrutiny at the event scrutiny venue).

Outright points

Outright points will be allocated regardless of class, according to each competitor's total elapsed time for the event, after any penalties have been applied. To be eligible for outright points a competitor must complete the total race distance. See table below.

Class points

When an event is run as more than one section, class points will be allocated equally regardless of distance. To be eligible for class points a competitor must complete the total distance of that section within a specified time allowed.

In sprint events navigators are optional.

TITLES AND AWARDS

Only the driver is eligible for points. Competitors are only eligible for points with one entry per event. A driver can nominate a navigator to receive end of championship awards.

Competitors born in 2007 up to 2000 inclusive are eligible for JUNIOR Championship points.

Competitors born in 2008 up to 2011 inclusive are eligible for FUTURE CHAMPIONS Championship points.

REGISTRAR

It is the responsibility of the event organisers to notify the registrar of event results within seven days to enable timely processing of Championship points. The results should show outright times for the event and also section times per class.
