The Off Road *Future Champions* Class Regulations

This class has been considered to provide an avenue for the development of younger drivers in Off Road Racing at an earlier age than is currently allowed. This will align it to other genres of racing for example karting or speedway.

The age

The minimum age is 10 years up to 13 years for drivers who must be accompanied by a co-Driver 18 years or over who holds a minimum of a current AASA State Off Road Drivers Licence.

The event

Held on an off road race track with a maximum of 15 mins race time per heat for each driver. It may be run as a separate event or run as a separate heat in a state off road event, consisting of this class of drivers only. There should be no other class competitors on the track at the time the Future Champions are driving.

There should be an assigned official to monitor each competitor before and after each heat.

The vehicle

May be any of the following:

Class 66 UTV up to 1000 cc NA standard. The permitted changes to standard are:

Steel may be added for strengthening.

Shock absorbers may be changed but not the number. The original shock mounts must not be changed.

Class 3 1300cc buggy -as per standing regulations

Class 7 production 4WD – as per standing regulations

Safety requirements

As per AASA sprint event regulations

Neck restraint – a minimum of level 1

Scrutineering

Drivers will be checked for correct seat and harness fitment at scrutineering. Appropriate helmet size will also be checked.
